Development and Infrastructure Committee: 12 November 2024. Economic Development Grants and Cost of Living Crisis Business

Support Schemes.

Budget Monitoring Statement and Delegated Approvals. Report by Corporate Director for Enterprise and Sustainable Regeneration.

1. Overview

- 1.1. In March 2024, the Council approved the revenue budget for financial year 2024/25. This included an initial Economic Development Grants budget of £300,400, along with capability to over-commit by 5%, which increased the budget to £315,400.
- 1.2. Spending to 30 September 2024, in relation to Economic Development Grants totalled £139,696, of which £79,751 relates to grant commitments made in previous financial years and £59,945 to current year commitments.
- 1.3. The budget available for approval from the Economic Development Grants budget as at 30 September 2024, amounted to £134,942, as detailed in Annex A to this report.
- 1.4. Grant approvals made in the period 1 April to 30 September 2024 totalled £180,458, including grants approved under delegated schemes for the same period totalled £140,458, and are detailed in Annex B to this report.
- 1.5. On 21 February 2023, the Policy and Resources Committee recommended that the following Cost of Living Crisis Business Support Schemes should operate for a period of two years to 28 February 2025, funded from the unassigned remaining balance of the Coronavirus Response Fund, estimated at £1.3 million, and reported to the Development and Infrastructure Committee in addition to standard reporting of Economic Development Grants budget monitoring:
 - Council Business Hardship Support Grant (BHSG).
 - Council loan facility.
 - Energy resilience and transition support.
 - Exceptional requests.

1.6. Approvals made in the period 1 April to 30 September 2024, totalling £120,000, in respect of Cost of Living Crisis Business Support Schemes, are summarised in Annex C to this report.

2. Recommendations

- 2.1. It is recommended that members of the Committee:
 - Note spending to 30 September 2024, in relation to Economic Development Grants totalling £139,696, of which £79,751 relates to grant commitments made in previous financial years and £59,945 to current year commitments.
 - Note grant approvals made in the period 1 April to 30 September 2024 totalling £180,458, including grants approved under delegated schemes for the same period, totalling £140,458 as detailed in Annex B to this report.
 - Note approvals made in the period 1 April to 30 September 2024, totalling £120,000, in respect of Cost of Living Crisis Business Support Schemes, as summarised in Annex C to this report.
