

Item: 10 Education, Leisure and Housing Committee: 2 April 2025. Care Inspectorate Visit – Stronsay Junior High Nursery. Report by Corporate Director for Education, Leisure and Housing.

# 1. Overview

- 1.1. On 18 September 2024, the Care Inspectorate undertook an unannounced inspection of Stronsay Junior High Nursery.
- 1.2. The inspection team gave the following key messages:
  - Children were safe, loved and secure in their attachments.
  - Children were developing their curiosity, imagination and problem-solving skills through high quality play experiences.
  - Children were very happy and engaged and having fun in various activities, both indoors and outdoors.
  - Very good use was being made of loose parts and open-ended resources to enrich children's play and learning.
  - Children experienced very warm, caring and nurturing support from staff who knew them very well.
  - Positive relationships with families supported continuity of care and effective partnerships.
  - The manager and staff were committed to the ongoing development of the service to provide children with a service of high standard.
  - Continuous improvement was supported by good quality assurance systems.
- 1.3. The four key quality indicators from the Care Inspectorate Quality Framework used in the inspection were as evaluated as follows:
  - How good is our play, care and learning? Good.
  - How good is our setting? Very good.
  - How good is our leadership? Very good.
  - How good is our staff team? Very good.
- 1.4. The report was very positive, and the Care Inspectorate made no requirements or recommendations.
