Development and Infrastructure Committee: 28 March 2023.

Road Asset Replacement Programme and Roads Revenue Maintenance Programme.

Report by Corporate Director for Neighbourhood Services and Infrastructure.

1. Purpose of Report

To consider the proposed Road Asset Replacement Programmes for 2023 to 2026 and the proposed Roads Revenue Maintenance Programme for 2023/24.

2. Recommendations

The Committee is invited to note:

2.1.

That, on 15 February 2022, the Development and Infrastructure Committee approved the Road Asset Replacement Programme for 2022/23, together with indicative programmes for 2023/24 and 2024/25.

2.2.

That a multi-year approach to the replacement of road assets allows for greater flexibility to vary the timing of individual projects where constraints and/or pressures emerge.

2.3.

That, on 21 December 2021, when considering the allocation of one-off funding towards a series of projects considered to provide excellent recovery prospects from the COVID-19 pandemic, the Policy and Resources Committee recommended the allocation of funding to a series of recovery projects, which included a one-off allocation of £500,000 towards ditching and offlets.

2.4.

That, on 23 February 2023, when considering a strategy for managing the Council's General Fund Reserves in the context of setting the Revenue Budget for 2023/24, the Policy and Resources Committee recommended that the one-off allocation towards ditching and offlets be reduced to £400,000 as part of the budget setting process for financial year 2023/24.

2.5.

The proposed Road Asset Replacement Programme for 2023/24, together with indicative programmes for 2024/25 and 2025/26, attached as Appendix 1 to this report.

2.6.

That, although approval is sought for a multi-year programme in respect of Road Asset Replacement, the Corporate Director for Neighbourhood Services and Infrastructure will continue to submit reports, on an annual basis, presenting updated programmes for subsequent years.

2.7.

The proposed Roads Revenue Maintenance Programme for 2023/24, attached as Appendix 2 to this report.

It is recommended:

2.8.

That the Road Asset Replacement Programme for 2023/24, together with indicative programmes for 2024/25 and 2025/26, attached as Appendix 1 to this report, be approved.

2.9.

That the Roads Revenue Maintenance Programme for 2023/24, attached as Appendix 2 to this report, be approved.

2.10.

That powers be delegated to the Corporate Director for Neighbourhood Services and Infrastructure, in consultation with the Head of Finance, to adjust the Roads Asset Replacement Programme and Roads Revenue Maintenance Programmes referred to at paragraph 2.8 and 2.9 above, as variations arise and in order to maximise use of budget allocations.

3. Background

3.1.

A top sliced annual allowance of £950,000 is included within the capital programme in respect of the Road Asset Replacement Programme (RARP).

3.2.

On 15 February 2022, the Development and Infrastructure Committee approved the RARP for 2022/23, together with indicative programmes for 2023/24 and 2024/25.

3.3.

On 5 May 2021, the Council approved a Roads Revenue Maintenance Programme, to use a £2.1 million contribution to the Repairs and Renewals Fund to improve the Council's network asset by addressing repairs to the road network, exacerbated in 2020/21 by COVID-19 restrictions and severe winter weather.

3.4.

An allocation of £1.050 million of the Repairs and Renewals Fund was shared between Roads Revenue Maintenance and Capital Roads Asset Replacement programmes and allocated in each of the financial years 2021/22 and 2022/23. This funding will be fully spent by 31 March 2023.

3.5.

Transport Scotland has, for several years, provided capital grant funding in respect of Cycling, Walking and Safer Routes (CWSR) projects. To ensure governance and accountability on the use of this recurring funding, works are reported as part of the RARP for monitoring purposes.

4. Asset Condition

4.1.

If current budget positions remain in place, the roads asset will continue to deteriorate over the long-term. This will result in far greater quantities of defects and will impact both the financial and staffing resource available to the Roads Service.

4.2.

To maintain the network at the same condition, a budget of £2.75 million would be required for surface treatments. The current budget is just over £1 million which highlights the difficulty in finalising a treatment programme that addresses all current priorities.

4.3.

Therefore, it must be noted that the proposed treatment programmes attached will not resolve the backlog of high priority sites and it is expected that the general road condition will be worse this time next year.

4.4.

Course visual inspections continue to be carried out throughout the year; as a result, it is necessary for officers to have an element of flexibility built into the programme to pull forward projects should the need arise.

5. Road Asset Replacement Programme

5.1.

The programme for routine replacement of the roads infrastructure and associated assets is summarised under the headings of Associated Infrastructure, Drainage, Street Lighting, Bridges and Structures, Reconstruction and Surface Treatments.

5.2.

The proposed three-year RARP consists of previously identified priorities following asset inspection. The programmes for 2024/25 and 2025/26 are indicative only and will be reassessed as required to reflect ongoing priorities and budget pressures. Annual progress on the current year's programme, together with updated programmes for subsequent years will continue to be presented to the Committee.

5.3.

The CWSR grant offer for 2023/24 is expected to be £98,000 and has been included in the programme.

6. Roads Revenue Maintenance Programme

6.1.

An additional allocation of £1.050 million was used to address repairs to the road network in each of the financial years 2021/22 and 2022/23.

6.2.

The two-year programme of additional revenue work, which included routine maintenance in relation to surface treatment, patching, drainage works and bridges and structures, has now come to an end as it will be fully spent by 31 March 2023.

6.3.

Prior to the additional funding, referred to at section 3.3 above, the Roads Revenue and Maintenance Programme was not submitted to Committee. This programme continues to be predominantly based on reactive works. Works are identified following inspection, customer comments or incidents on the network. These are prioritised and planned and programmed accordingly. Consequently, the information contained in the programme for 2023/24 has not been fully developed.

6.4.

At its special meeting held on 21 December 2021, when considering the allocation of one-off funding towards a series of projects considered to provide excellent recovery prospects from the COVID-19 pandemic, the Policy and Resources Committee recommended the allocation of funding to a series of recovery projects, which included a one-off allocation of £500,000 towards ditching and offlets.

6.4.1.

These works continue to be planned and programmed as required, however, it should be noted that on 23 February 2023, when considering a strategy for managing the Council's General Fund Reserves in the context of setting the Revenue Budget for 2023/24, the Policy and Resources Committee recommended that this funding be reduced to £400,000 as part of the budget setting process for financial year 2023/24.

6.5.

To demonstrate best value and ensure that funding is allocated to best enhance the asset value, an assessment of the network continues to be carried out to ensure improvements are targeted to those work streams and in those areas where funding will provide the greatest value for money for users across Orkney.

7. Corporate Governance

7.1.

This report relates to the Council complying with its financial processes and procedures and therefore does not directly support and contribute to improved outcomes for communities as outlined in the Council Plan and the Local Outcomes Improvement Plan.

7.2.

In terms of the Scheme of Administration, the establishment and review of the annual road asset replacement programme, funded through the approved capital programme and revenue budgets, is delegated to the Development and Infrastructure Committee.

8. Financial Implications

8.1.

The approved capital programme includes a provision of £950,000 in respect of the RARP for financial year 2023/24.

8.2.

The Council has not received a grant offer for 2023/24 from Transport Scotland in respect of CWSR projects. That said, the Council has been notified through the annual financial settlement to expect a figure of £98,000 for financial year 2023/24.

8.3.

For expenditure to be considered as an improvement or enhancement and count as being capital in nature it must lengthen substantially the useful life of the asset, increase substantially the open market value or increase substantially the extent to which the asset can be used.

9. Legal Aspects

9.1.

When purchasing new roads assets, the Council must comply with the Contract Standing Orders.

9.2.

Section 1(1) of the Roads Scotland Act 1984 states that: "a local roads authority shall manage and maintain all such roads in their area as are for the time being entered in a list (in this act referred to as their "list of public roads") prepared and kept by them under this section; and for the purposes of such management and maintenance (and without prejudice to this subsection's generality) they shall, subject to the provisions of this act, have power to reconstruct, alter, widen, improve or renew any such road or to determine the means by which the public right of passage over it, or over any part of it, may be exercised.
