Road Asset Replacement Programme and Roads Revenue Maintenance Programme.

Expenditure Outturn.

Report by Head of Finance.

1. Purpose of Report

To advise of the expenditure outturn on the approved Road Asset Replacement and Roads Revenue Maintenance Programmes for financial year 2022/23.

2. Recommendations

The Committee is invited to note:

2.1.

The summary outturn position of expenditure incurred for financial year 2022/23 in respect of the Road Asset Replacement Programme and the Roads Revenue Maintenance Programme, as detailed in section 4.1 of this report.

The Committee is invited to scrutinise:

2.2.

The detailed analysis of expenditure figures and programme updates, attached as Appendices 1 and 2 to this report, in order to obtain assurance with regard to significant budget variances and progress made with delivery of the approved Road Asset Replacement Programme and the Roads Revenue Maintenance Programme.

3. Background

3.1.

On 23 February 2021, the Policy and Resources Committee recommended that a contribution of £2.1 million, funded from the non-earmarked General Fund balance, be made to the Repairs and Renewals Fund, to be utilised specifically for roads and paths repairs and renewals works.

3.2.

On 30 March 2021, when considering a plan for addressing supplemental roads and paths repairs and renewal works, the Development and Infrastructure Committee noted the indicative Road Asset Repairs and Renewal Fund Programmes for

2021/22 and 2022/23 in respect of the capital and revenue works, attached as Appendix 1 to the report by the Executive Director of Development and Infrastructure.

3.3.

The Committee thereafter recommended to the Policy and Resources Committee:

- That the contribution of £2.1 million, be allocated equally over financial years 2021/22 and 2022/23 as follows:
 - o Roads Revenue Maintenance £683,400 (65%).
 - Road Asset Replacement Programme (capital works) £366,600 (35%).
- That the annual Road Revenue Maintenance budget and the Road Asset Replacement Programme relating to capital works be enhanced by £683,400 and £366,600 respectively for each of financial years 2021/22 and 2022/23.

3.4.

The additional funding was used to supplement existing capital and revenue expenditure for 2021/22 with the remainder to be expended during 2022/23, in respect of repairs and renewal to the road network and associated infrastructure, exacerbated in 2020/21 by COVID-19 restrictions and the severe winter weather experienced in recent years.

3.5.

In order to demonstrate best value and ensure that funding is allocated accordingly, an assessment of the networks has been undertaken to identify areas where funding will provide the greatest value for money for users across Orkney, with the enhanced revenue maintenance programme reported through the established budget monitoring arrangements. The additional funding is now fully spent and enhanced reporting will not continue; however consideration is being given to enhanced reporting of the Roads Revenue Maintenance Programme as part of the existing revenue expenditure monitoring.

3.6.

The Corporate Asset Management Plan 2019 to 2023 takes account of guidance produced by the Chartered Institute of Public Finance and Accountancy and has streamlined the suggested framework to incorporate and complement the existing Capital Project Appraisal system.

3.7.

The Corporate Asset Management Plan summarises the Council's aims and objectives for its assets to ensure that they are used in an effective and efficient manner. This has been further supplemented by the Property Asset Management Plan approved on 10 December 2019.

3.8.

The purpose of this report is to present an overview or summary of the expenditure incurred in financial year 2022/23 against the approved programmes to allow Members the opportunity to scrutinise the spending levels against approved budgets and gauge the extent to which the Council's assets are routinely being maintained and replaced.

4. Budget Outturn

4.1.

The undernoted table shows the outturn position of expenditure incurred for the period 1 April 2022 to 31 March 2023, against the respective programmes.

4.2.

The original budget for the Roads Revenue Maintenance Programme refers to the maintenance components of the annual roads revenue budget for financial year 2022/23. The revised budget refers to the detailed road maintenance programme for 2022/23, attached as Appendix 2 to this report.

4.3.

A detailed breakdown of the planned capital and revenue maintenance works undertaken during financial year 2022/23, together with expenditure as at 31 March 2023, compared directly with the approved programmes, are attached as Appendices 1 and 2 to this report respectively.

5. Road Asset Replacement Programme

5.1.

All annual capital improvement and replacement programmes, including the Road Asset Replacement Programme, are funded by a top-slice from the General Capital Grant each year. In financial year 2022/23, the annual programme of £950,000 was increased to £1,741,600, as follows:

• £464,200 remaining contribution from the Repairs and Renewal Fund, detailed at section 3.3 above, being the allocation of £366,600 for 2022/23 and a further £97,600 carried forward from 2021/22.

- £135,000 in respect of the Local Bridge Maintenance fund, funded via a Scottish Government grant.
- £143,400 in respect of the Cycling, Walking and Safer Routes grant award for 2022/23.
- £49,000 in respect of unclaimed Cycling, Walking and Safer Routes grant for 2021/22 carried forward into 2022/23, with the approval of the grant provider.

5.2.

The Road Asset Replacement Programme realised an underspend of £310,685 against the revised allocated budget of £1,741,600. Some planned work was unable to be completed due to resource constraints within the Council's own roads operation team.

6. Roads Revenue Maintenance Programme

6.1.

The Roads Revenue Replacement Programme for 2022/23, including the additional budget contribution from the Repairs and Renewals Fund, realised an underspend of £22,550.

6.2.

The annual budget of £1,057,100 was increased as follows:

- £683,400 contribution from the Repairs and Renewal Fund, as recommended by Policy and Resources Committee on 20 April 2021.
- £135,800 in respect of unspent allocation for 2021/22 from the Repairs and Renewal Fund contribution referred to above.

6.3.

The annual programme of roads surface dressing was cancelled to enable the roads team to concentrate on delivering other areas of the programme.

7. Corporate Governance

This report relates to the Council complying with its governance and financial processes and procedures and therefore does not directly support and contribute to improved outcomes for communities as outlined in the Council Plan and the Local Outcomes Improvement Plan.

8. Financial Implications

8.1.

This report monitors progress across both the Road Asset Replacement Programme and the Roads Revenue Maintenance Programme for financial year 2022/23, both of which were increased by £366,600 and £683,400 respectively, following approval of £2.1 million additional funding to be used over two financial years in respect of roads and path repairs and remedial works.

8.2.

The Financial Regulations state that service directors are able to incur expenditure within approved revenue and capital budgets. Such expenditure must be in accordance with the Council's policies and objectives and subject to compliance with the Financial Regulations and approved schemes of delegation.

8.3.

The development of a corporate approach to asset management planning should lead to efficiencies in the use of fixed assets, together with the potential for rationalisation of the Council's property estate going forward.

8.4.

More detailed monitoring of expenditure on the Road Asset Replacement Programme and the Roads Revenue Maintenance Programme will result in improved accountability in relation to the deliverance of the approved programmes of work and ensure Members are kept informed of progress.

9. Legal Aspects

Regular financial monitoring and reporting help the Council meet its statutory obligation to secure best value.
