Inter-Island Ferry Services – Proposed Sunday Winter 2021/22 Services.

Report by Interim Executive Director of Finance, Regulatory, Marine and Transportation Services.

1. Purpose of Report

To consider the proposed inter-island ferry services timetables for a Sunday service for winter 2021/22 for Rousay, Egilsay and Wyre and Hoy and Flotta and a winter 2021/22 service to Papa Westray.

2. Recommendations

The Committee is invited to note:

2.1.

That additional funding has been received from the Scottish Government for financial year 2021/22 to operate a winter Sunday service for Rousay, Egilsay and Wyre and Hoy and Flotta.

2.2.

That the Papa Westray passenger ferry service to Pierowall, operated during the winter months, has been brought in-house, with services due to operate from 27 September 2021.

2.3.

The draft timetables to operate a winter Sunday service for Rousay, Egilsay and Wyre and Hoy and Flotta and the winter 2021/22 service for Papa Westray, attached as Appendices 1 and 2 respectively to this report.

2.4.

That the draft timetables were presented to the Ferry Services Consultative Forum for consideration on 25 August 2021.

2.5.

That the proposed timetables, together with feedback from the Ferry Services Consultative Forum, have been considered by the Board of Orkney Ferries Limited and recommended to the Council for implementation.

It is recommended:

2.6.

That the timetables in respect of ferry services to be operated by Orkney Ferries Limited to operate a winter Sunday service for Rousay, Egilsay and Wyre and Hoy and Flotta and the winter 2021/22 service for Papa Westray, attached as Appendices 1 and 2 respectively to this report, be approved.

3. Background

3.1.

In accordance with the Service Level Agreements entered into by Orkney Ferries Limited and the Council, a recommendation from the Board of Orkney Ferries must be made via the Head of Marine Services and Transportation in order for the winter and summer timetable periods to be approved by this Committee.

3.2.

The six Outer North Isles Community Councils each appoint a Transport Representative to represent their respective communities on the Inter-Isles Ferry Service Consultative Forum.

3.3.

Additional funding has been received from the Scottish Government for financial year 2021/22 to operate a winter Sunday service for Rousay, Egilsay and Wyre and Hoy and Flotta.

3.4.

The winter Papa Westray passenger service was previously operated by a private contractor, with invoices predominantly issued to Education, Leisure and Housing, NHS Orkney and the Church of Scotland for services. The contractor notified the Council that they would be retiring in Spring 2021 and therefore Orkney Ferries Limited undertook an exercise to determine whether to continue to contract services or, alternatively, bring these in-house, consistent with the summer service. Following a consultation exercise, it was determined that the best value option would be to bring services in-house.

4. Ferry Services Consultative Forum

4.1.

The timetables to operate a winter Sunday service for Rousay, Egilsay and Wyre and Hoy and Flotta and the winter 2021/22 service for Papa Westray, which were drafted in consultation with the communities, were considered by the Ferry Services Consultative Forum on 25 August 2021.

4.2.

It was noted that, following the additional funding from Scottish Government towards inter island ferry services during 2021/22, additional crew had been appointed on MV

Hoy Head to serve Hoy and Flotta, and MV Eynhallow to serve Rousay, Egilsay and Wyre, providing year-round Sunday services.

4.3.

It was further noted that the Papa Westray passenger ferry timetable may need to be altered to accommodate the transport of a Nursery Nurse Teacher. As there has been no specific request from Education, Leisure and Housing and there was no representation from Education at the forum, this will need to be discussed further and therefore the timetable may be subject to change.

4.4.

Sunday services for Hoy and Flotta will commence subject to crewing availability and therefore may not commence at the start of the winter timetable for 2021/22.

4.5.

The proposed timetables, attached at Appendix 1 of this report, which did not form part of the winter 2021/22 timetables considered by Committee earlier this year, together with feedback from the Ferry Services Consultative Forum, have been considered by the Board of Orkney Ferries Limited and recommended to the Council for implementation.

5. Corporate Governance

This report relates to governance and procedural issues and therefore does not directly support and contribute to improved outcomes for communities as outlined in the Council Plan and the Local Outcomes Improvement Plan.

6. Financial Implications

6.1.

The Inter Island Ferries Service revenue budget of £12,612,500 for financial year 20201/22 includes a specific grant of £7,855,000 from Scottish Government.

6.2.

The specific grant allocation is based on the Council's revised baseline budget submission for fair funding for the inter-island ferry services to Scottish Government in January 2021. While the overall request was based on operating the existing fleet with enhancements, as proposed in the 2019 Ferries Revenue Outline Business Case, it also included an allowance of £700,000 for the introduction of year-round Sunday sailings across the existing network.

6.3.

The specific grant allocation of £7,855,000 for financial year 2021/22 represents an increase of £2,532,000 or 47.6%, on the previous year's grant allocation of £5,323,000. While this is very welcome it is notable that, as with any grant funding

that has yet to be baselined, the risk remains that this level of support may not be continued beyond the current financial year.

7. Legal Aspects

7.1.

Section 153 (2) of the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973 empowers the Council to "acquire, provide, maintain, improve and operate any ferry situated wholly or partly within their area".

7.2.

Orkney Ferries Limited operates the ferry services on behalf of Orkney Islands Council under Service Level Agreements dated 30 May 2008.

7.3.

The Service Level Agreements state that the timetables for the summer period should be recommended by the Company to the Council's Development and Infrastructure Committee for approval.

7.4.

The Service Level Agreements state that Orkney Ferries Limited will operate the "Approved Services" and in return for funding from the Council. The definition of Approved Services" covers inter-island ferry services as approved by the Council.
