1. Planning Application 17/283/PIP

Proposed Siting of House at Heimdal, St Ola

After consideration of a report by the Chief Executive, copies of which had been circulated, the Local Review Body:

Noted:

1.1. That planning permission for the proposed siting of a house at Heimdal, St Ola, was refused by the Appointed Officer on 17 August 2017, for the reasons outlined in section 4.2 of the report by the Chief Executive.

- **1.2.** That the applicant had submitted a Notice of Review requesting that the decision of the Appointed Officer, referred to at paragraph 1.1 above, be reviewed.
- **1.3.** That, in accordance with policy, the Local Review Body had undertaken an unaccompanied visit to the site, referred to at paragraph 1.1 above, at 09:30 on 24 January 2018.

After hearing a report from the Planning Advisor, the Local Review Body:

Resolved, in terms of delegated powers:

1.4. That the review be determined without further procedure.

Councillor Robin W Crichton, seconded by Councillor Barbara Foulkes, moved that the decision of the Appointed Officer, to refuse the application for the proposed siting of a house at Heimdal, St Ola, be upheld.

Councillor Owen Tierney, seconded by Councillor John A R Scott, moved an amendment that planning permission in principle be granted in respect of the proposed siting of a house at Heimdal, St Ola, as, in their opinion, the house of Upper Scapa constituted a fourth house associated with the three other properties at Heimdal, Beach View and Swartland, therefore meeting the definition of a housing group as detailed in the Supplementary Guidance: Housing in the Countryside, requiring a housing group to consist of four or more occupied and independent dwelling houses which related to each other and were viewed as a group, and the proposed site therefore conformed with all the necessary criteria for single house infill development within existing housing groups, and accordingly, the proposed development would comply with Policy 5 – Housing, Section E: Single Houses and New Housing Clusters in the Countryside of the Orkney Local Development Plan 2017.

On a vote being taken 7 members voted for the amendment and 2 for the motion, and the Local Review Body:

Resolved, in terms of delegated powers:

- **1.5.** That planning permission in principle be granted in respect of the proposed siting of a house at Heimdal, St Ola, subject to the conditions attached as Appendix 1 to this Minute.
- **1.6.** That the Local Review Body's reason for granting planning permission in principle was that, in the Local Review Body's opinion:
- **1.6.1.** The house of Upper Scapa constituted a fourth house associated with the three other properties at Heimdal, Beach View and Swartland, therefore meeting the definition of a housing group as detailed in the Supplementary Guidance: Housing in the Countryside, requiring a housing group to consist of four or more occupied and independent dwelling houses which related to each other and were viewed as a group, and the proposed site therefore conformed with all the necessary criteria for single house infill development within existing housing groups.

And, accordingly, the proposed development was in accordance with Policy 5 – Housing, Section 3: Single Houses and New Housing Clusters in the Countryside of the Orkney Local Development Plan 2017.
