**Development and Infrastructure Committee: 15 February 2022.** 

Road Asset Replacement Programme and Roads Revenue Maintenance Programme.

**Expenditure Monitoring.** 

Report by Head of Finance.

## 1. Purpose of Report

To monitor expenditure incurred against the Road Asset Replacement and Roads Revenue Maintenance Programmes as at 31 December 2021.

### 2. Recommendations

The Committee is invited to note:

#### 2.1.

The summary position of expenditure incurred, as at 31 December 2021, against the Road Asset Replacement Programme and the Roads Revenue Maintenance Programme for 2021/22, as detailed in section 4.1 of this report.

The Committee is invited to scrutinise:

#### 2.2.

The detailed analysis of expenditure figures and programme updates, attached as Appendices 1 and 2 to this report, in order to obtain assurance with regard to significant budget variances and progress being made with delivery of the approved Road Asset Replacement Programme and the Roads Revenue Maintenance Programme.

## 3. Background

#### 3.1.

On 23 February 2021, the Policy and Resources Committee recommended that a contribution of £2.1 million, funded from the non-earmarked General Fund balance, be made to the Repairs and Renewals Fund, to be utilised specifically for roads and paths repairs and renewals works.

#### 3.2.

On 30 March 2021, when considering a plan for addressing supplemental roads and paths repairs and renewal works, the Development and Infrastructure Committee noted the indicative Road Asset Repairs and Renewal Fund Programmes for 2021/22 and 2022/23 in respect of the capital and revenue works, attached as

Appendix 1 to the report by the Executive Director of Development and Infrastructure.

#### 3.3.

The Committee thereafter recommended to the Policy and Resources Committee:

- That the contribution of £2.1 million, be allocated equally over financial years 2021/22 and 2022/23 as follows:
  - Roads Revenue Maintenance £683,400 (65%).
  - Road Asset Replacement Programme (capital works) £366,600 (35%).
- That the annual Road Revenue Maintenance budget and the Road Asset Replacement Programme relating to capital works be enhanced by £683,400 and £366,600 respectively for each of financial years 2021/22 and 2022/23.

#### 3.4.

The additional funding will be used to supplement existing capital and revenue expenditure for 2021/22 and 2022/23, in respect of repairs and renewal to the road network and associated infrastructure, exacerbated in 2020/21 by COVID-19 restrictions and the recent severe winter weather.

#### 3.5.

In order to demonstrate best value and ensure that funding is allocated accordingly, an assessment of the networks has been undertaken to identify areas where funding will provide the greatest value for money for users across Orkney, with the enhanced revenue maintenance programme reported through the established budget monitoring arrangements.

#### 3.6.

A revised programme of works in respect of the Roads Revenue Maintenance Programme for financial year 2021/22 was subsequently agreed by the Development and Infrastructure Committee on 7 September 2021.

#### 3.7.

The Corporate Asset Management Plan 2019 to 2023 takes account of guidance produced by the Chartered Institute of Public Finance and Accountancy and has streamlined the suggested framework to incorporate and complement the existing Capital Project Appraisal system.

#### 3.8.

The Corporate Asset Management Plan summarises the Council's aims and objectives for its assets to ensure that they are used in an effective and efficient manner. This has been further supplemented by the Property Asset Management Plan approved on 10 December 2019.

#### 3.9.

The purpose of this report is to present an overview or summary of the expenditure incurred as at 31 December 2021 to allow Members the opportunity to scrutinise the spending levels against approved budgets and gauge the extent to which the Council's assets are routinely being maintained and replaced.

## 4. Budget Monitoring

#### 4.1.

The undernoted table shows the position of expenditure incurred for the period 1 April to 31 December 2021, against the respective programmes.

### 4.2.

The original budget for the Roads Revenue Maintenance Programme refers to the maintenance components of the annual roads revenue budget for financial year 2021/22. The revised budget refers to the detailed road maintenance programme for 2021/22, attached as Appendix 2 to this report. The detailed programme replaces the indicative road maintenance programme that was previously endorsed by the Service Committee on 30 March 2021.

#### 4.3.

A detailed breakdown of the planned capital and revenue maintenance works to be undertaken during financial year 2021/22, together with expenditure as at 31 December 2021, compared directly with the approved programmes, are attached as Appendices 1 and 2 to this report respectively.

## 5. Road Asset Replacement Programme

#### 5.1.

Actual spend on the Road Asset Replacement Programme as at 31 December 2021 is £680,223.

#### 5.2.

All annual capital improvement and replacement programmes, including the Road Asset Replacement Programme, are funded by a top-slice from the General Capital Grant each year. In financial year 2021/22, the annual programme of £950,000 has been increased as follows:

- £98,000 in respect of the Cycling, Walking and Safer Routes grant award for 2021/22.
- £49,000 in respect of unclaimed 2020/21 Cycling, Walking and Safer Routes grant carried forward into 2021/22, with the approval of the grant provider.
- £366,600 contribution from the Repairs and Renewal Fund, as recommended by Policy and Resources Committee on 20 April 2021.
- £131,400 draw down of 2022/23 contribution from the Repairs and Renewal fund, as authorised by the Chief Executive, up to a maximum of £300,000 in 2021/22.

#### 5.3.

On 20 April 2021, the Policy and Resources Committee recommended that £22,967 of the 2021/22 Cycling, Walking and Safer Routes grant allocation be redirected to fund an element of the Open Space and Play Area at Papdale East. The resulting budget reduction has been offset by a successful application to the HITRANS Active Travel Grant fund, with £23,000 awarded for 2021/22.

#### 5.4.

The Road Asset Replacement Programme for 2021/22 is currently projecting an overspend of £7,021 at year end. Unplanned works that took place in the first quarter of the financial year resulted in an overspend, however this has been offset by compensatory savings across the entire programme to help ensure the programme is delivered within budget for 2021/22.

### 6. Roads Revenue Maintenance Programme

#### 6.1.

Actual spend on the Roads Revenue Maintenance Programme as at 31 December 2021 is £1,217,990.

#### 6.2.

Safety and course visual inspections are ongoing in order to identify any further work that will be required to be added to the 2021/22 programme of revenue maintenance. It is anticipated that the revised budget will be overspent by £74,305 as at 31 March 2022, with a probable outturn of £1,814,805. The projected overspend is the result of increased costs associated with additional plant and resources required to ensure COVID-19 health and safety guidance is adhered to during surface treatment works. It is anticipated that this position will be offset by compensatory savings across the entire programme before 31 March 2022, to ensure the programme is delivered within budget for 2021/22.

### 7. Corporate Governance

This report relates to the Council complying with its governance and financial processes and procedures and therefore does not directly support and contribute to improved outcomes for communities as outlined in the Council Plan and the Local Outcomes Improvement Plan.

### 8. Financial Implications

#### 8.1.

This report monitors progress across both the Road Asset Replacement Programme and the Roads Revenue Maintenance Programme for financial year 2021/22. These programmes were increased by £366,600 and £683,400 respectively, following approval of £2.1 million of additional funding to be used over two financial years in respect of roads and path repairs and remedial works.

#### 8.2.

The Financial Regulations state that service directors are able to incur expenditure within approved revenue and capital budgets. Such expenditure must be in accordance with the Council's policies and objectives and subject to compliance with the Financial Regulations and approved schemes of delegation.

#### 8.3.

The development of a corporate approach to asset management planning should lead to efficiencies in the use of fixed assets, together with the potential for rationalisation of the Council's property estate going forward.

#### 8.4.

More detailed monitoring of expenditure on the Road Asset Replacement Programme and the Roads Revenue Maintenance Programme will result in improved accountability in relation to the deliverance of the approved programmes of work and ensure Members are kept informed of progress.

## 9. Legal Aspects

Regular financial monitoring and reporting help the Council meet its statutory obligation to secure best value.
