Road Asset Replacement Programme.

Report by Executive Director of Development and Infrastructure.

## 1. Purpose of Report

To consider the proposed Road Asset Replacement Programme for 2021 to 2024.

### 2. Recommendations

The Committee is invited to note:

### 2.1.

That, on 30 June 2020, the Council approved the Road Asset Replacement Programme for 2020/21, together with indicative programmes for 2021/22 and 2022/23.

### 2.2.

That a multi-year approach to the replacement of road assets allows for greater flexibility to vary the timing of individual projects where constraints and/or pressures emerge.

#### 2.3.

That, in order to improve the governance and accountability surrounding use of the Cycling, Walking and Safer Routes capital grant, all works are reported as part of the Road Asset Replacement Programme for monitoring purposes.

### 2.4.

The proposed programme for 2021/22, together with indicative programmes for 2022/23 and 2023/24, in respect of road asset replacement, attached as Appendix 1 to this report, estimated at £1,048,000 for each financial year.

### 2.5.

That, although approval is sought for a multi-year programme, the Executive Director of Development and Infrastructure will continue to submit reports, on an annual basis, to provide progress updates of the current year's programme and present an updated programme for subsequent years.

#### It is recommended:

### 2.6.

That the Road Asset Replacement Programme for 2021/22, together with the indicative programmes for 2022/23 and 2023/24, attached as Appendix 1 to this report, be approved.

### 2.7.

That powers be delegated to the Executive Director of Development and Infrastructure, in consultation with the Head of Finance, to adjust the three year programme, referred to at paragraph 2.6 above, as variations arise in order to maximise use of the annual capital allocation.

## 3. Background

### 3.1.

A top sliced annual allowance of £950,000 is included within the capital programme in respect of the Road Asset Replacement Programme (RARP).

#### 3.2.

On 30 June 2020, the Council approved a RARP for 2020/21, together with indicative programmes for 2021/22 and 2022/23.

#### 3.3.

For several years now, Transport Scotland has made available capital grant funding in respect of Cycling, Walking and Safer Routes (CWSR) projects. In order to improve the governance and accountability surrounding the use of this recurring capital grant funding, works are now reported as part of the RARP for monitoring purposes, with effect from financial year 2019/20.

## 4. Road Asset Replacement Programme

### 4.1.

The programme for routine replacement of the roads infrastructure and associated assets is summarised under the headings of Associated Infrastructure, Drainage, Street Lighting, Bridges and Structures, Reconstruction and Surface Treatments.

### 4.2.

The proposed three-year RARP consists of previously identified priorities following asset inspection. The programmes for 2022/23 and 2023/24 are indicative only and will be reassessed as required to reflect ongoing priorities and budget pressures. Annual progress on the current year's programme, together with updated programmes for subsequent years will continue to be presented to the Committee.

### 4.3.

The CWSR grant offer for 2021/22 is expected to be £98,000 and has been included in the programme.

## 5. Corporate Governance

This report relates to the Council complying with its financial processes and procedures and therefore does not directly support and contribute to improved outcomes for communities as outlined in the Council Plan and the Local Outcomes Improvement Plan.

## 6. Financial Implications

### 6.1.

The approved capital programme includes a provision of £950,000 in respect of the RARP for financial year 2021/22.

#### 6.2.

At this time the Council has not received a grant offer for 2021/22 from Transport Scotland in respect of CWSR projects. That said, the Council has been notified through the annual financial settlement to expect a figure of £98,000 which is broadly in line with the grant award for the current financial year 2020/21 at £96,000.

### 6.3.

For expenditure to be considered as an improvement or enhancement and count as being capital in nature it must lengthen substantially the useful life of the asset, increase substantially the open market value or increase substantially the extent to which the asset can be used.

# 7. Legal Aspects

### 7.1.

When purchasing new roads assets, the Council must comply with the Contract Standing Orders.

#### 7.2.

Section 1(1) of the Roads Scotland Act 1984 states that: "a local roads authority shall manage and maintain all such roads in their area as are for the time being entered in a list (in this act referred to as their "list of public roads") prepared and kept by them under this section; and for the purposes of such management and maintenance (and without prejudice to this subsection's generality) they shall, subject to the provisions of this act, have power to reconstruct, alter, widen, improve or renew any such road or to determine the means by which the public right of passage over it, or over any part of it, may be exercised.
