**Care Inspectorate – Papdale Primary School Nursery.** 

Report by Corporate Director for Education, Leisure and Housing

## 1. Purpose of Report

To advise of the findings of the recent Care Inspectorate inspection report of Papdale Primary School Nursery undertaken in June 2022.

- How good is our leadership?
- How good is our staff team?

That Papdale Primary School Nursery was inspected by the Care Inspectorate in June 2022.

That, of the four areas inspected, one received an excellent grading and three received a very good grading.

#### 3.1.

Papdale Primary School Nursery was inspected in June 2022. The inspection report is attached at Appendix 1 to this report.

# 4. Summary of Inspection

#### 4.1.

The areas inspected by the Care Inspectorate, referred to in section 3.1 above, were graded as follows:

- How good is our care, play and learning: very good
  - 1.1 Nurturing care and support very good
  - 1.3 Play and learning excellent
- How good is our setting: very good
  - 2.2 Children experience high quality facilities very good
- How good is our leadership: excellent
  - 3.1 Quality assurance and improvement are well led excellent
- How good is our staff team: very good
  - 4.3 Staff deployment very good

#### 4.2.

The following key strengths were identified:

- Children were very well nurtured and supported throughout their daily experiences.
- Children experienced warm, caring and nurturing interactions with staff.
- Children were effectively supported by staff who worked closely with other agencies, when appropriate, to further meet the needs of children.
- Children had fun as they experienced an excellent quality of play, learning and development opportunities.
- Staff used children's interests to provide considered and creative approaches to play.
- Children's learning, development and well-being needs were met in an excellent indoor area.
- Children and families were supported by a manager who had a very positive approach to improvement and welcomed any feedback.
- Quality assurance arrangements made a positive impact in maintaining and improving high quality of care for children.
- The high-quality care of children was supported by positive staffing arrangements to promote continuity of care across the day.
