

THE ORKNEY ISLANDS COUNCIL (VARIABLE 20 MPH SPEED LIMIT)
(SCHOOLS IN EVIE AND FIRTH) ORDER 2007

The Orkney Islands Council in exercise of its powers under Section 84(1) and (1A) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1 This Order may be cited as The Orkney Islands Council (Variable 20 mph Speed Limit) (Schools in Evie and Firth) Order 2007 and shall come into operation on the First day of April Two Thousand and Seven.
- 2 The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament. In this Order, the expression "vehicle" means a vehicle of any description and includes a machine or implement of any kind drawn or propelled along a road whether or not by mechanical power.
- 3 (a) No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order at a speed exceeding -
 - (i) twenty miles per hour at a time when such a speed limit is indicated by a traffic sign in accordance with Article 3(b) hereof; or
 - (ii) forty miles per hour at any other time.(b) Such an indication may be given between the hours of 7.30 a.m. and 5 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive, and at no other time.
- 4 This Order, where its provisions conflict, supersedes the Orders specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.

SCHEDULE 1

- (a) Evie Primary School
- The public road A966 leading from Finstown to Birsay at Evie, from a point twenty one metres eight hundred millimetres or thereby southeast of the northmost corner of the property known as Redland, Evie, generally in a southeasterly direction to a point forty one metres eight hundred millimetres or thereby southeast of the southeastmost corner of the property known as Ferrybreck, Evie, a distance of two hundred and thirty metres or thereby
- (b) Firth Primary School
- The public road A966 leading from Finstown to Evie at Firth Primary School, from a point twenty one metres two hundred millimetres or thereby southwest of the southwestmost corner of the northwest parapet of the bridge over The Ouse, Firth, in a northnortheasterly direction to a point at the southwestmost corner of the property known as Govilon, Firth, a distance of two hundred and twenty metres or thereby

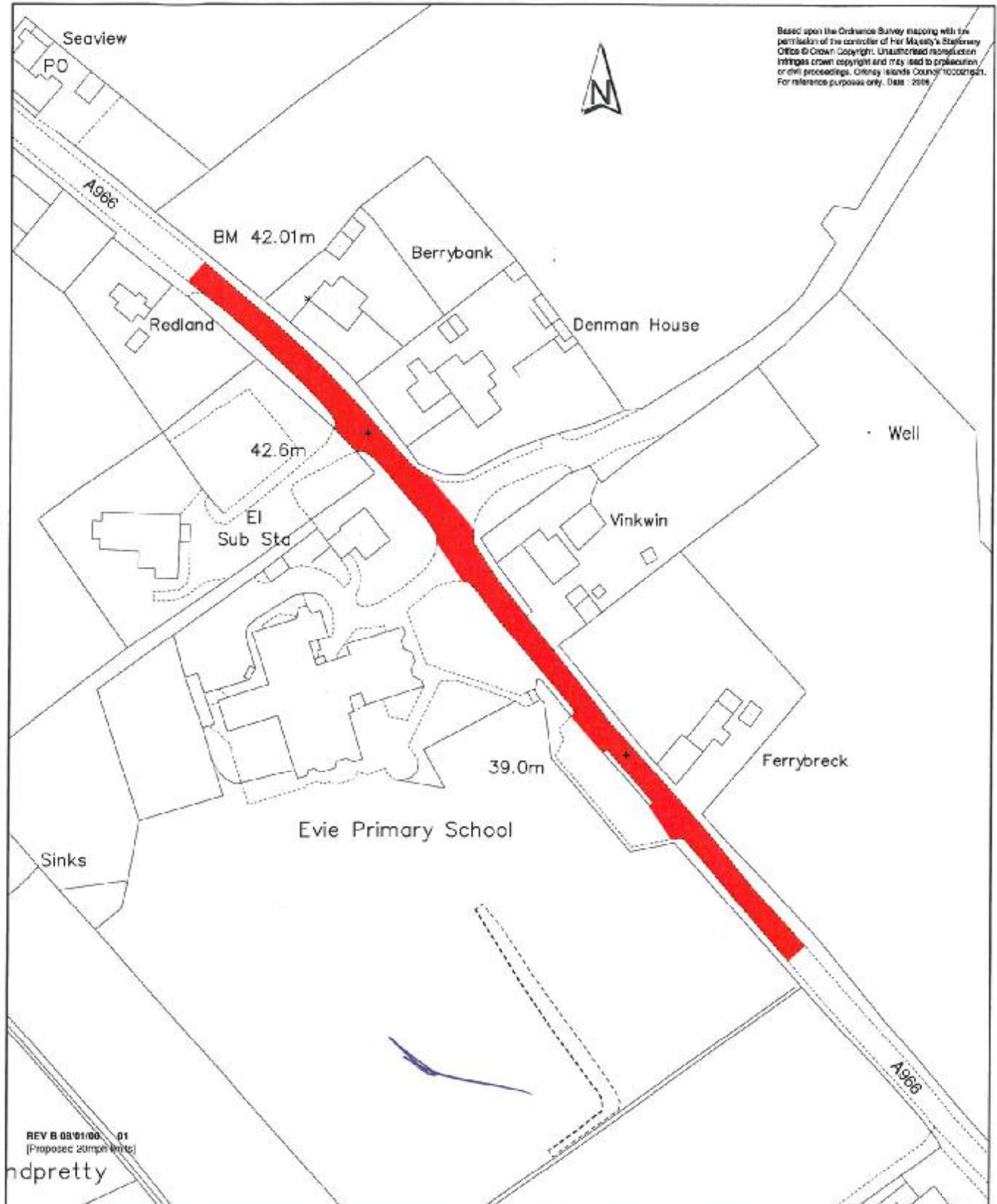
SCHEDULE 2
