The marine plan has been prepared to guide decision making on coastal and marine developments and activities in Orkney.

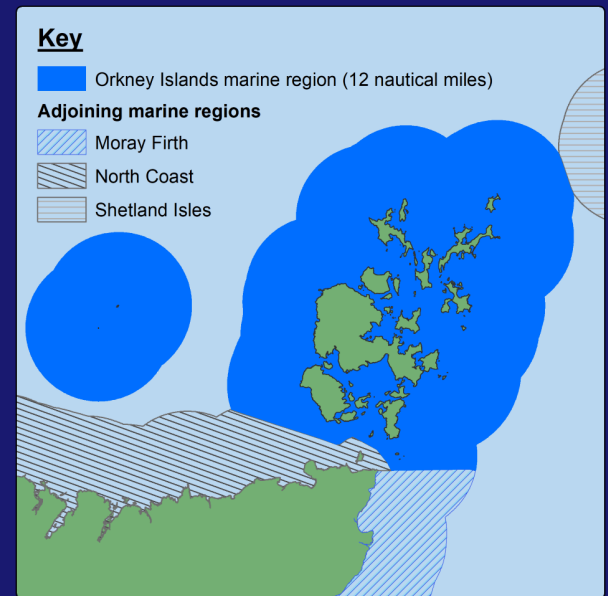


Consultation
